Pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. s. 552, I request access to and copies of the entire final investigation of the Army Criminal Investigation Division (CID) into the death of my son, Sgt. Loren J. Janeczko, ss# [REDACTED] who was killed on October 12, 2001.

I have recently been made aware of the fact that such a report has been sent to the 307th MP Company in New Kensington, PA on April 8, 2003. However, as it has not been opened, there is no reference number which I can refer to in making my request.

I agree to pay reasonable duplication fees for the processing of this request in an amount not to exceed \$25.00. However, please notify me prior to your incurring any expenses in excess of that amount.

If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the act. I will also expect you to release all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any information or to deny a waiver of fees.

I look forward to your reply within 20 business days, as the statute requires. Thank you for your assistance.
