Wood River Technologies, Inc. (WRT) hereby requests a series of budget, contract and contact information documents under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).

Although FOIA does not require us to disclose our intended use of the information, we feel that it is appropriate that we do so in this instance.

WRT plans to use the requested documents to publish free email content for government contractors on doing business with Homeland Security agencies and to promote an online subscription service providing Homeland Security business development information.

Our Homeland Security free content and subscription product will support of the administrations expressed policy of involving the private sector in the war against terrorism.

Pursuant to the Federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 5 552, I request the following documents for the Federal Protective Service and the Federal Computer Incident Response Center:

- A page of a document containing the name and telephone number (and email address if available) of the employing Directorate of the Project Officer (or Contracting Officer's Technical Representative) for the active contracts the Federal Computer Incident Response Center and the Federal Protective Service have listed with the Federal Procurement Data Center for FY 2001. We are interested in only active contracts that will be repeated. The requested page may be from the contract document itself or any other document maintained by these agencies.
- A page of a document containing the names and telephone numbers (and email addresses if available) of the contracting officer and the contracting specialist for the active contracts listed with FPDC, again we are interested in only active contracts that will be repeated. The requested page may be from the contract document itself or any other document maintained by the Federal Computer Incident Response Center and the Federal Protective Service.
