Honduran Minister of the Presidency Carlos Flores informed Ambassador April 30 that he believed he had gained some solid support for GOH peace plan during April 28 meetings with other Latin American Foreign Ministers in Washington. Flores specifically mentioned Venezuela, Panama, Colombia, Dominican Republic, Argentina, Peru, Ecuador, Brazil.
3. Flores said he still wasn't sure of form of next step. OAS resolution is one possibility, as has been discussed
