SITREP COVERING PERIOD 120500H JUN TO 121800H JUN 94.

1. GEN. SITUATION. THE DAY STARTED WITH HOSTILITIES BETWEEN THE TWO WARRING FACTIONS IN KIGALI. HEAVY ARTY/MORTAR AND SMALL ARMS FIRE WAS EXCHANGED BY BOTH SIDES FROM EARLY THIS MORNING TILL LATE AFTERNOON. THE MAIN AREAS OF FIGHTING WERE KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO, KIMISAGARA AND IN THE CITY CENTER. ABOUT 10 SHELLS LANDED CLOSE TO THE ICRC HOSPITAL. THERE IS NO MAJOR CHANGE IN THE DISPOSITION OF THE TWO WARRING FACTIONS IN THE NORTH OF THE COUNTRY. IN THE SOUTH, FIGHTING IS REPORTED TO BE GOING ON IN THE AREA EAST OF GITARAMA. THE INFLUX OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO THE SOUTH STILL CONTINUES. GENDARMERIE AND MILITIA CONTINUE TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: NTR.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED TO PUT PRESSURE ON ISOLATED RGF POSITIONS IN KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER WITH HEAVY SHELLING DURING THE DAY. TROOPS IN THE ISLAMIC CENTER ARE STILL UNDER SIEGE BY THE RGF/MILITIA. REPORTED TO HAVE NOW SURROUNDED GITARAMA ON THREE FRONTS. CONTAINING RGF POSITIONS IN RUHENGERI AND OTHER AREAS OF THE NORTH.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUE TO RESPOND TO RPF FIRE WITH MORTARS AND HMG FIRE FROM THEIR POSITIONS WITHIN THE CITY. STILL HOLDING THEIR POSITIONS IN KYCHIKIRU, KIMIHURURA, GATSATA AND THE CITY CENTER. REPORTED TO HAVE SUSTAINED HEAVY CASUALTIES IN FIGHTING AROUND OF GITARAMA IN THE SOUTH. REPORTED TO BE CARRYING OUT AMBUSHES ON RPF CONVOYS SOUTH OF GITARAMA. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN DISPOSITIONS UP NORTH.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA CONTINUE TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS. IT HAS BEEN OBSERVED THAT THEIR ACTIVITIES ARE ON THE INCREASE IN THE CITY, IN AREAS UNDER RGF CONTROL.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES:

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE WORKS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. THE ROUTINE STAFF BRIEF WAS CONDUCTED AT 0800 HRS. THE FC IS STILL IN NAIROBI.

B. UNOMUR. AREA REMAINED CALM. ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN AOR DURING THE PERIOD. CP/OP AT MERRAMA HILLS REPORTED THE PROBABLE EXISTENCE OF AN RPF RECRUITING/TRAINING CAMP LOCATED IN THE VICINITY OF KAGITUMBA(SQ 5183). 24 DIFFERENT HUMANITARIAN RELIEF AGENCIES CROSSED THE BORDER THROUGH KATUNA TO RWANDA WITH HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS. A TOTAL OF 62 VEHICLES CROSSED THE BORDER AT

KATUNA, KASHEKYE, KYANIKA AND MERAMA HILLS TO RWANDA WITH 867 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 626 REFUGEES. 58 VEHICLES CROSSED INTO UGANDA WITH 231 PASSENGERS. APPROXIMATELY 6000 RWANDESE CROSSED THE BORDER AT KYANIKA TO WORK AND MARKETING AND RETURNED THE SAME DAY. THREE HELICOPTERS ARE PRESENTLY OPERATIONAL.

C. BYURAT. AREA AROUND KIA WAS GENERALLY CALM. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM. A CHURCH SERVICE WAS HELD AT KIA BETWEEN 0900HRS AND 1000HRS. THE DFC PAID A WORKING VISIT TO THE BN HQ AT KIA. A THREE YEARS OLD CHILD DIED AT THE KIA DISPLACED PERSONS CAMP.

D. TUM PLATOON (+). AREA OF OPERATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM. PROVIDED SECURITY AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT MILLE COLLINS HOTEL, MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. ALSO PROVIDED APC ESCORT DURING THE DAY.

E. MILGE TWO MILOB TEAMS ESCORTED UNAMIR PERSONNEL AND JOURNALISTS TO KAGITUMBA (UGANDAN BORDER CROSSING POINT) ON THEIR WAY TO NAIROBI. THE TEAM REPORTED THAT RPF TROOPS SEARCHED THEIR VEHICLE AND LUGGAGE EVEN AFTER IDENTIFYING THEMSELVES AS UNAMIR PERSONNEL. MILOBs ALSO PROVIDED ESCORTS TO ICRC, MSF, WFP AND PSF OFFICIALS. ONE TEAM REMAINS DEPLOYED AT ST FAMILLE.

5. UNICEF. 15 ARE STILL IN NAIROBI.

6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. PSF VISITED KIGALI PREFECTURE WITH HAC LIAISON OFFICER TO CONFIRM SAFETY OF DISPLACED PERSONS IN NYAMIRAMBO. UNICEF CARRIED OUT VACCINATION OF DISPLACED PERSONS AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND THE AMAHORO STADIUM. 10 SHELLS LANDED AROUND ICRC HOSPITAL. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES. WFP DELIVERED 217 BOXES OF BISCUITS TO KIA AND 217 BOXES TO AMAHORO STADIUM. ICRC ACCOMMODATED 250 INJURED PERSONS IN A TENT AT NYANZA. ICRC DELIVERED 10 TONS OF BEANS, 28 TONS MAIZE AND 1 TON OF COOKING OIL TO CYANGUGU BY BOAT OVER LAKE KIVU. ICRC TREATED 15 PATIENTS IN THEIR HOSPITAL.
