Pursuant to action of the United States Intelligence Board (USIB) we are forwarding the National Intelligence Estimates (NIEs) and Special National Intelligence Estimates (SNIEs) indicated in the attached list. Because of the interest which your representatives had indicated in estimates dealing with subjects such as guided missiles, space vehicles, atomic energy, and over-all Soviet military and scientific pelicies and capabilities, the Board believed that these papers would be of particular interest.

National Intelligence Estimates are treated as sensitive documents and given special security handling regardless of the classification of the particular estimate. Moreover, this group of estimates includes papers of unusual sensitivity, certain of which have highly classified annexes. For that reason, certain of the estimates and annexes will be sent to you through different channels including the following: ME 11-2-58; Annex C and Annex D to ME 11-5-57; Annex B and Annex C to ME 11-5-58; and the Annex to NE 100-2-58. Our understanding is that you are in a position to store and handle these estimates in a manner commensurate with their classification, and that they will be made available only to properly cleared people with a need-to-know.
