3. ON THE BASIS OF DEPUTIES COMMITTEE WORK ON THIS ISSUE, I APPROACHED MY TALKS IN ALL THREE CAPITALS WITH THE VIEW THAT WE SHOULD WORK TOWARD A COORDINATED US, JAPANESE, CHINESE AND SOVIET APPROACH TO BUILDING POLITICAL PRESSURES ON THE NORTH TO SIGN AND IMPLEMENT AN IAEA SAFEGUARDS REGIME AND TO WORK OUT WITH THE SOUTH KOREANS, BASED ON PRESIDENT ROH TAE WOO'S NOVEMBER 8 INITIATIVE, A NORTH-SOUTH COMMITMENT TO FORGO NUCLEAR REPROCESSING CAPABILITIES. I DID NOT PROPOSE ANY FORMAL TWO PLUS FOUR APPROACH TO THIS EFFORT. INDEED, I STRESSED TO PRESIDENT ROH THAT WHATEVER WE WOULD DO WITH THE MAJOR POWERS WOULD BE IN SUPPORT OF THE NORTH-SOUTH

TALKS AND WOULD NOT UNDERCUT SOUTH KOREA'S LEAD ON SECURITY AND POLITICAL ISSUES IN DEALING WATH THE NORTH. AND I AFFIRMED OUR IMMENTION TO SUSTAIN CLOSE CONSULTATIONS WITH THE SOUTH.

4. PRESIDENT ROH INDICATED HE IS FULLY PREPARED TO COORDINATE HIS APPROACH TO THE NORTH CLOSELY WITH US. HE STRESSED THAT HIS NOVEMBER 8 INITIATIVE WAS DESIGNED TO REINFORCE THE PRESIDENT'S SEPTEMBER 27 NUCLEAR INITIATIVE. HE APPRECIATED OUR SENSITIVITY TO THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN GERMANY AND KOREA, AND HIS NATIONAL SECURITY ADVISOR KIM CHONG-WHI MADE IT CLEAR THAT KOREANS DON'T WANT JAPAN OR THE SOVIET UNION INVOLVED IN THE POLITICS OF THE PENINSULA, EVEN THOUGH THEY HAVE A ROLE TO PLAY ON THE NUCLEAR ISSUE.

WE WANT TO AVOID A LINKAGE BETWEEN OUR FORCE LEVELS AND THE NORTH'S PROGRAM. WE WANT TO MAKE CLEAR TO THE SOUTH KOREANS THAT THE NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION ISSUE IS ONE OF STRONG REGIONAL AND GLOBAL CONCERN, AND THAT THEY ARE UNLIKELY TO GET THE NORTH TO AGREE TO GIVE UP THEIR NUCLEAR PROGRAM WITH THEIR EFFORTS ALONE. THE US REMAINS KEY TO ORCHESTRATING INTERNATIONAL PRESSURES ON THEIR BEHALF. IN MY MIND, THIS ALSO MEANS THAT WHILE WE NEED TO BE SENSITIVE TO SOUTH KOREA'S CONCERNS, THEY NEED TO APPRECIATE THAT OUR SECURITY COMMITMENT AND INTERESTS GIVE US A BIG SAY, TOO.

SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT, BUT ALSO FOREGOING A REPROCESSING CAPABILITY. SOME JAPANESE BUREAUCRATS MAY SEEK TO NIBBLE AWAY AT THIS POSITION, BUT WE SHOULD HOLD THEM TO IT. WE MUST CONTINUE TO WORK IN TANDEM WITH JAPAN ON THIS ISSUE.

- 8. THE CHINESE STILL WORRY ABOUT NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA. THEY COMMUNICATED THIS CONCERN TO KIM IL-SONG IN OCTOBER BUT DID NOT PRESS HIM HARD TO SIGN AND IMPLEMENT THE SAFEGUARDS REGIME OR FOREGO REPROCESSING. THEY PUBLICLY SUPPORT KIM'S PROPOSAL FOR A NUCLEAR WEAPONS FREE ZONE ON THE PENINSULA, BUT ALSO SAY THE PRESIDENT'S SEPTEMBER 27TH INITIATIVE IS A POSITIVE STEP. IN SEOUL LAST WEEK, CHINESE FOREIGN MINISTER QIAN STATED PUBLICLY HIS CONCERN ABOUT NUCLEAR WEAPONS ON THE PENINSULA, BUT HE ALSO SAID DIALOGUE RATHER THAN PRESSURE WOULD WORK BEST WITH THE NORTH. THE CHINESE PROBABLY SEE THE ISSUE MUCH AS WE DO, BUT BELIEVE THEIR LEVERAGE IS GREATER IF THEY ARE NOT TOO CLOSE TO THE AMERICANS. IN ADDITION, THE CHINESE WANT TO BE CAREFUL NOT TO UNDERMINE THE POSITION OF ONE OF THEIR FEW REMAINING COMMUNIST BROTHERS.
- 9. IN BEIJING THE CHINESE PROPOSED CROSS-RECOGNITION TO EASE PYONGYANG'S FEARS OF ISOLATION AND INSECURITY AND THUS MOVE THEM TO SIGN ON TO THE IAEA INSPECTION REGIME. THEY ALSO URGED US TO TALK AT A HIGHER LEVEL SECRET

THE CHINESE DID AGREE TO PRIVATE CONSULTATIONS AND TO A PUBLIC STATEMENT THAT WE WOULD BOTH WORK ON THE PROLIFERATION ISSUE BASED ON SHARED US/PRC CONCERNS ABOUT THE NUCLEAR PROBLEM ON THE PENINSULA. WE WILL BUILD ON THIS BASE WITH BEIJING.

11. I WILL BE INTERESTED IN YOUR OWN READOUT OF YOUR SCM DISCUSSIONS IN SEQUE. WE ALL KNOW THIS IS AN URGENT MATTER, AND I THINK AT THIS POINT THAT WE ARE STARTING TO BUILD THE BASIS FOR A PARALLEL STRATEGY OF COORDINATED DIPLOMATIC PRESSURES ON THE NORTH-COMBINED WITH ROK INITIATIVES THROUGH THE NORTH-SOUTH TALKS-AND
