It obvious that above speculation cannot lead to assumption that Soviet agreement to NPT text largely on our terms presages fundamental shift in Soviet policy terms toward FRG, EURATOM, or Western European integration movement. Believe basic Soviet policy unchanged in this respect, and Soviet reaction to detente overtures on part Western Europeans will continue reflect this fact. However, we would expect that NPT as another building block in structure of postwar agreements with Soviets regarding nuclear weapons cannot help but have positive effect on differences between East and West.
