THE TALIBAN ARE NOW REPORTED BY RELIABLE OPPOSITION SOURCES TO BE LESS THAN 30 KILOMETERS SOUTH OF HERAT CITY AIRPORT. THE KABUL GOVERNMENT SAYS A COUNTER-ATTACK TO DRIVE THE TALIBAN BACK IS BEING PLANNED, BUT ISMAEL KHAN IS CLEARLY POLITICALLY AND MILITARILY WEAKENED.
