OF ATTEMPT AGAINST SCHNEIDER WAS ENTRUSTED TO ELEMENTS LINKED WITH VIAUX. IMPORTANT FACTOR TO BEAR IN MIND IS THAT ARMED FORCES, AND NOT RETIRED OFFICERS OR EXTREME RIGHTISTS, SET SCHNEIDER UP FOR EXECUTION OR ABDUCTION. SHOULD THIS BECOME KNOWN, IMPACT ON ARMED FORCES WOULD BE TREMENDOUS. UNIDAD POPULAR MAY ACTUALLY SUSPECT THIS TO BE THE CASE. BEFORE TRYING TO ANTICIPATE FURTHER COURSE OF EVENTS STATION WOULD LIKE TO AVAIT EVERTS OF 23RD OCT WHICH WILL OBVIOUSLY BE DECISIVE. PREVAILING OPINION IN EMBASSY APPEARS TO BE THAT ARMED FORCES WILL CAVE AND THAT SCHNEIDER'S SUCCESSOR GEN. CARLOS PRATTS. IS GOING TO INSURE ORDERLY TRANSFER OF POWER TO ALLENDE. CAN SAY IS THAT ATTEMPT ABAINST SCHNEIDER IS AFFORDING ARMED FORCES ONE LAST OPPORTUNITY TO PREVENT ALLENDE'S ELECTION IF THEY ARE WILLING TO FOLLOW VALENZUELA'S SCENARIO. SEC
