I am in receipt of your letter of May 22, 1973, concerning certain highly classified documents turned over to U.S. District Judge John Sirica on May 14, 1973. You will recall that I had Assistant Director Edward S. Miller and Special Agent Thomas J. Smith call on you and Senator Baker on May 14, 1973, following publicity attendant to the turning over of these documents to Judge Sirica.

I appreciate the offer you have extended to the FBI to furnish advice concerning the sensitivity of these documents. We would welcome an opportunity to afford you and others of the Select Committee, whom you designate, a personal briefing of the documents and to discuss any problems which could arise from public disclosure of them.

Since material in the documents relates to other agencies of the intelligence community, we can only address ourselves to material which affects the FBI.
