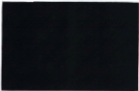

Dear Mr. President:

By my letter of April 15, 1951, I recommended, inter alia, that you authorize the Atomic Energy Commission and the Secretary of Defense to proceed with the disposal of atomic weapons in accordance with the plan of January 26, 1951, with the understanding that no further disposition for allocation to the U. S. Navy would be made under that authority. We were informed of your approval by your letter of May 25, 1951.
