THO SEPARATE MEETINGS WERE HELD AT FRENCH FUREIGN OFFICE ON TECHNICAL ASPECTS OF PAKISTAN NUCLEAR PROGRAM AND MATTERS (SEPTEL). IN THE FIRST MEETING, THE FRENCH RERE REPRESENTED BY LEYGONIE (ACTING SECRETARY, NUCLEAR POLICY COUNCIL), COL. ROBERT BLIN AND GENERAL MONTRELAY TGENERAL SECRETARIAT FOR NATIONAL DEFENSE), FRANCOIS BEBILLEAU (CEA) AND GOTTLIES (DEPUTY TO LOUET). THE US DELEGATION INCLUDED FRIEDMAN (SCICOUNS), GALLUCCI (3/P), AND LOCKE (PM/NPP). IN THE SECOND MEETING, THE FRENCH DELEGATION ALSO INCLUDED COATES (CEA) AND THE US HAS REPRESENTED BY KRATZ (OOL/ISA), VANSTRUM (UAR RIDGE) AND GRAHAM (ACDA/NP).

IN THE FIRST MEETING, THE FRENCH BEGAN BY REPEATING THE INFORMATION PHOVIDED REFTEL ON THEIR BELIEF THAT PAKISTAN IS USING MARAGING STEEL RATHER THAN ALUMINUM FOR CENTRIFUGE ROTGRS AND THEIR BELIEF THAT MARAGING STEEL HAD BEEN IMPORTED FROM THE NETHERLANDS. COURING THE AFTERNOUN, THE FRENCH SAID THAT THEY BELIEVE THE ENTIRE CENTRIFUGE, END CAPS, BELLOWS AND ROTORS, WAS MADE OF HARAGING STEEL. THEY MENTIONED A TWO ROTUR MACHINE BUT DID NOT REAFFIRM THE STATEMENT DURING DISCUSSION. THE GOF CUNCLUDED THIS FROM ANALYSIS OF TECHNICAL INFORMATION PROVIDED TO THE FRENCH COMPANY CALORSTAT (SEE PARA 4) AND FROM THE FRENCH KNOWLEDGE OF URENCO TECHNOLOGY.) IN RESPONSE TO FRENCH REQUEST FOR INFORMATION ABOUT ENRICHMENT SITES IN PAKISTAN, GALLUCCI BRIEFLY DESCRIBED STATUS OF PAKISTAN NUCLEAR PROGRAM IN THE SAME TERMS USED IN INFORMAL MEETING IN VIENNA THE PREVIOUS DAY (SEPTEL). PRENCH INTELLIGENCE REPRESENTATIVE STATED THAT THE GOF HAS INFURNATION THAT THE KAHUTA CENTRIFUGE FACILITY MODELO ASTART UP" WITHIN A MONTH. WHEN WUESTIONED ABOUT EXACT MEANING, I.E. WHETHER CONSTRUCTION OR OPERATION OF CASCADES HOULD START UP, THE FRENCH SIDE WAS UNSURE. THEY RECOGNIZED THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THIS INFORMATION AND PROMISED FOLLOW UP. IN ADDITION THE FRENCH PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING INFURMATION ON THE EXPORT OF SAFEGUARDED AND UNSAFEGUARDEU URANIUM TO PAKISTAN FROM NIGER. SAFEGUARDED URANIUM HAS SENT TO PAKISTAN IN 1977 (50 TONNES), JUNE 1978 (50 TONNES), MARCH 1979 (ABOUT 10 TONNES). IN ADDITION THE FRENCH SATO THAT NIGER SENT UNSAFEGUARDED URANIUM TO PAKISTAN BY AIR THROUGH LIBYA UNDER PAKISTANI GUARDS. ACCORDING TO FRENCH INTELLIGENCE SOUNCES, SHIPMENTS OF UNSAFEGUARDED URANIUM HERE MADE IN 1978 (15 TUNNES), JANUARY 1979

(150 TONNES), AND MARCH 1979 (150 TUNNES). THEY BELIEVED THAT THE UNANIUM WAS IN CONCENTRATED FORM. THE FRENCH STATED THAT THEY HAD NO KNOWLEGGE WHERE THE URANIUM WAS BEING CONVENTED TO UPS.

IN THE AFTERNOON, THE FRENCH PROVIDED THE FOLLOHING INFORMATION ON COOPERATION BETWEEN PAKISTAN AND THE FRENCH COMPANY CALONSTAT. PRIOR TO JULY 1977, THE PAKISTANI EMBASSY IN BONN CONTACTED THIS FRENCH COMPANY AND REQUESTED IT TO MANUFACTURE BELLOWS. PREVIOUSLY THIS COMPANY HAD NOT MURKED UN ANY PART OF THE FRENCH CENTRIFUGE PROGRAM, BUT IT HAD HURKED ON "SOME OTHER NUCLEAR PROJECTS." INITIALLY, WHILE UTILIZING EXISTING TECHNOLOGY AND EQUIPMENT, THE FRENCH COMPANY COULD NOT PRODUCE BELLOWS TO HEET THE AFTER THIS TIME THE PAKISTANIS PAKISTANIS! NEEUS. PROVIDED THE COMPANY WITH DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS FUR THE BELLOWS. IN JUNE 1977 THE FIRST CONTRACT BETHEEN THE PAKISTAN EMBASSY IN BONN AND CALORSTAT HAS SIGNED

FOR THE PHODUCTION OF AN UNSPECIFIED NUMBER OF BELLOWS. BETWEEN JUNE 1977 AND SEPTEMBER 1978, 20 PROTOTYPE BELLOWS WERE PRODUCED AND DELIVERED TO A HR. BUTT AT THE PAKISTAN EMBASSY IN BONN. (THIS IS PRESUMABLY SHAFIQ AHHAD BUTT, SCIENTIFIC MINISTER-COUNSELOR IN PAKISTAN EMBASSY IN PARIS.) IN SEPTEMBER 1978, AN ADDITIONAL 20 BELLOWS WERE PRODUCED AND DELIVERED TO THE SAME PERSON. IN OCTOBER 1978 AN ORDER WAS PLACED WITH THE SAME COMPANY THROUGH THE PARISTANI EMBASSY IN FRANCE TO PRODUCE 10,000 BELLUND. THESE BELLOWS WERE TO HAVE BEEN PRODUCED WITH NEW BELLONS FORMING THIS NEW BELLOWS FORMING EQUIPMENT WAS MANUFACTURED BY CALORSTAT ACCURDING TO TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS WHICH WERE PROVIDED BY THE PAKISTANIS, AFTER THE CUNTRACT WAS SIGNED, 2 PROTOTYPE AND THEN 18 BELLOWS WERE PRODUCED AND DELIVERED. IN FEBRUARY 1979, 200 BELLOAS WERE PRODUCED AND DELIVERED. 600 BELLOWS WERE DELIVERED TO PAKISTAN. THIS LAST SHIPMENT HAS IMPROPERLY MARKED TO AVOID FRENCH CUSTUM CONTRULS. THE FRENCH HAVE ADDED BELLUKS TO THEIR EXPORT CONTROL LIST AND HAVE TOLD THE COMPANY THAT IT MUST NOT SHIP ANY BELLOWS OR BELLOWS FORMING EQUIPMENT TO PAKISTAN.

5. DURING THE AFTERNUON SESSION, THE FRENCH STATED THAT THEY HAD NO DIRECT EVIDENCE THAT PARISTAN HAD ACTUALLY SECRET

MADE ANY ROTORS DUT OF MARAGING SIEEL, BUT THEY BELIEVE IT TO BE THE CASE BASED ON THEIR ANALYSIS OF THE TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS PROVIDED CALORSTAT AND THE GOF KNOWLEDGE OF URENCO DESIGNS. DURING THAT DISCUSSION, THE FRENCH STATED THAT THEY HAD "A COPY OF A URENCO DESIGN," WHICH THE US DELEGATION BELIEVED WAS DIFFERENT FROM THE PAKISTANI DESIGN. THE FRENCH ASKED THE US TO PROVIDE INFORMATION WHICH HAD LED US TO CONCLUDE THAT THE PAKISTANIS ARE USING A DESIGN WITH "FOUR ALUMINUM TUBES SEPARATED BY BELLOWS AS HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN TOLD US." THE US DELEGATION COMMENTED THAT HE HOULD ATTEMPT TO PROVIDE INFORMATION AT A LATER DATE. IT WAS STATED THAT THE PAKISTANIS COULD BE UTILIZING MURE THAN ONE DESIGN.

6. IN RESPUNSE TO GUESTION PROVIDED BY INMISTA, THE FRENCH STATED THAT CALORSTAT HAD NOT SENT ANY BELLOWS

FORMING EQUIPMENT, SUCH AS FLUW TURNING EQUIPMENT TO PAKISTAN. THE FRENCH BELIEVED THAT THE PAKISTANIS COULD IMPORT EQUIPMENT FROM EUROPEAN COUNTRIES AND SUCCESSFULLY MAKE BELLOWS. WHEN ASKED WHY THE PAKISTANIS CHOSE TO PURCHASE BELLOWS FROM FRENCH COMPANY, GOF OFFICIALS STATED THAT PAKISTAN HAD IMPORTED BELLOWS BECAUSE "IT WAS EASIER." IT WAS ALSO SUGGESTED THAT A SHORTAGE OF SKILLED TECHNICIANS IN PAKISTAN HOULD MAKE THE PRODUCTION TASK DIFFICULT EVEN THOUGH THE TECHNOLOGY WAS AVAILABLE. THE FRENCH ALSO BELIEVED THAT THE PAKS COULD MANUFACTURE STEEL HOTORS. THE FRENCH IMPLIEU THROUGHOUT THEIR DISCUSSION THAT PAKISTAN WAS CONTINUING TO RECEIVE HELP FROM INDIVIDUALS SECRET

8. THE FRENCH ASKED WHETHER ACLESS TO ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY WOULD HELP THE PAKISTANIS TO PRODUCE A "LOWER TECHNOLOGY" CENTRIFUGE. US INDICATED THAT SUME TECHNICAL ADVANTAGE HOULD BE GAINED, BUT THAT MISTANES COULD BE MADE IN MODIFYING TECHNOLOGY, WHETHER INCREASING OR DECREASING ITS SOPHISTICATION. THE FRENCH ALSO ASKED MHY CERTAIN FIBER AND HESIN MATERIALS WERE NOT ON THE US LIST. WE ANSWERED THAT SOME FILAMENTARY MATERIALS WERE ALREADY UNDER CONTROL BECAUSE THEY WERE ON THE COCOM EMBARGO LIST.
