As reported in PRAVDA November 10, page 3, Khrushchev told Moscow Youth in half-jocular tones of easily assuaged dissidence among Rumanian students. No direct mention such dissidence has yet appeared in Rumanian press, however, and in SCANTEIA TINERETULUI November 11 report Moscow Youth meeting although remarks other speakers there briefly summarized only reference Khrushchev reads in full as follows: "Participants meeting greeted with stormy prolonged applause speech Khrushchev."

Legation considers treatment characteristic timidity combined tenacity on part essentially Stalinist Rumanian Communists.
