SENT DEPARTMENT 356, REPEATED INFORMATION MOSCOW 35

Western diplomatic source whose information in past has often proved reliable and who claims contacts some Rumanian Communists says latter had expected from visit Rumanian delegate Moscow (LEGTEL 355) about what Poles got, i.e., cancellation all debts to USSR incurred prior some very recent date; credit out of which Rumania might buy Soviet products chosen by selves; and increased prices of goods sold USSR. These Rumanian Communists say Rumania got no cancellation of debts; grain and fodder only in place credits; and no increased prices for Rumanian goods delivered to USSR. They severely disappointed this outcome, and particularly hurt by circumstance price paid for uranium ore not increased.
