MEMORANDUM FOR THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE

SUBJECT: Computer Security Project - Designation
of "Critical Systems" (U)

(S) This responds to your memorandum of 8 July 1983 which requests the identification of "critical systems" for a candidate list to be reviewed by the Executive Steering Group. One National Security Agency (NSA) computer system which comes within the bounds specified in your memorandum is WINDMILL, a Burroughs based system. WINDMILL contains a number of applications systems that are multiuser and processes sensitive compartmented intelligence and collateral information that may contain sensitive sources and methods. It is the host for the Signals Intelligence On-Line Information System (SOLIS), the National Signals Intelligence Requirements List (NSRL), and WEEDER, the Department of State electrical message file. In the future, it is scheduled to host additional collateral files. WINDMILL is a system that operates in a variety of multiuser modes from direct access to networked access (under COINS) and serves not only NSA operational requirements, but also those of the IC Staff and the Department of State. WINDMILL represents the optimum NSA system for review as a "critical system".
