~~SUBJECT: Radar, ANF-75 and RHM-73M FAN SOCK; Request for Acquisition of (S)~~

1. (U) Reference: DIRM-357-00, subject above, 29 June 1966.
2. (S) Reference memorandum, a copy of which has been passed to the Central Intelligence Agency, has provided timely support in obtaining State Department concurrence in collection operations against certain components of the SA-2 missile system.
3. (S) Collection efforts against the SA-2 system - the missile, the FAN SOCK radar, and the critical components of each - are fully coordinated with the CIA and with the Services. Within the past few days a set of missile guidance antennas (located beside the nozzle of the sustainer section) have been obtained by CIA and are undergoing exploitation at a contractor facility, with DoD specialists participating. Further collection action is in progress against the missile transponder, fuse, and autopilot, and possibly other components. These actions in no way dilute the effort against the complete system, but they do offer more immediate prospects of success. We will continue to inform you of the progress of these operations.
4. (S) The Director for Operations, Joint Staff has been provided a copy of the Registry Foreign Material Requirements Listing (U) (D-3842000). We will provide you with updating material as it is released, and when an urgent operational requirement arises for any item listed therein, or not yet so listed, we will welcome from you a statement of need similar to reference above. Such a statement assists us in focusing collection effort precisely, in obtaining necessary concurrence in collection action, in arranging immediate exploitation, and in securing requisite funding.
