BEGIN SUMMARY: THE AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL REPORT ON GUATEMALAN HUMAN RIGHTS SITUATION (CASA 27/82, AI INDEX AMR 34/24/82) SUBMITTED AS TESTIMONY TO THE PATTERSON SUBCOMMITTEE ON AUGUST 5 ASSUMES THAT THE GUATEMALAN ARMY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MAJORITY OF INCIDENTS SINCE MARCH 23 INVOLVING THE KILLING OF HUNDREDS OF NONCOMBATANT CIVILIANS. THIS, OF COURSE, SHOWS THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE VIEW OF THOSE (THE FAR-LEFT MEMBERS OF CUC -- A CAMPESINO ORGANIZATION) WHO OCCUPIED THE BRAZILIAN EMBASSY IN GUATEMALA LIMITED OFFICIAL USE
