BEGIN VERBATIM TEXT OF MEXICAN PROPOSALS

ARTICLE IV.

"1. NOTHING IN THIS TREATY SHALL BE INTERPRETED AS AFFECTING THE INALIENABLE RIGHT OF ALL THE PARTIES TO THE TREATY TO DEVELOP RESEARCH, PRODUCTION AND USE OF NUCLEAR ENERGY FOR PEACEFUL PURPOSES WITHOUT DISCRIMINATION AND IN CONFORMITY WITH ARTICLES I AND II OF THIS TREATY.

2. ALL THE PARTIES TO THIS TREATY HAVE THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FULLEST POSSIBLE EXCHANGE OF SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL INFORMATION ON THE PEACEFUL USES OF NUCLEAR ENERGY. THOSE PARTIES THAT ARE IN A POSITION TO DO SO, HAVE THE DUTY TO CONTRIBUTE, ACCORDING TO THEIR ABILITY, ALONE OR IN COOPERATION WITH OTHER STATES OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, TO THE FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF THE PRODUCTION,

INDUSTRIES, AND OTHER APPLICATIONS OF ANY NUCLEAR ENERGY FOR PEACEFUL PURPOSES, ESPECIALLY IN THE TERRITORIES OF NON-NUCLEAR-WEAPON STATES."

ARTICLE IV-A.

"1. NUCLEAR-WEAPON STATES PARTY TO THIS TREATY SHALL PROVIDE ADEQUATE MEANS AND FACILITIES TO MAKE AVAILABLE TO NON-NUCLEAR-WEAPON STATES PARTY TO THIS TREATY THE POTENTIAL BENEFITS FROM ANY PEACEFUL APPLICATIONS OF NUCLEAR EXPLOSIONS.

2. SUCH ASSISTANCE SHALL BE REQUESTED AND CHanneled THROUGH APPROPRIATE INTERNATIONAL BODIES WITH ADEQUATE REPRESENTATION OF NON-NUCLEAR WEAPON STATES, SUBJECT TO PROCEDURES TO BE ESTABLISHED IN A SPECIAL AGREEMENT; IT SHALL BE PROVIDED ON A NON-DISCRIMINATORY BASIS AND SHALL NOT BE WITHHELD BECAUSE OF EXTRANEOUS CONSIDERATIONS. THE CHARGE TO SUCH PARTIES FOR THE EXPLOSIVE DEVICES USED SHOULD BE AS LOW AS POSSIBLE AND

ARTICLE IV-B.

"NOTHING IN THIS TREATY AFFECTS THE RIGHT OF ANY GROUP OF STATES TO CONCLUDE REGIONAL TREATIES IN ORDER TO ASSURE THE TOTAL ABSENCE OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE TERRITORIES."

ARTICLE IV-C.

"EACH NUCLEAR-WEAPON STATE PARTY TO THIS TREATY UNDERTAKES TO PURSUE NEGOTIATIONS IN GOOD FAITH, WITH ALL SPEED AND PERSEVERANCE, TO ARRIVE AT FURTHER AGREEMENTS REGARDING THE PROHIBITION OF ALL NUCLEAR WEAPON TESTS, THE CESSATION OF THE MANUFACTURE OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS, THE LIQUIDATION OF ALL THEIR EXISTING STOCKPILES, THE ELIMINATION FROM NATIONAL ARSENALS OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS AND THE MEANS OF THEIR DELIVERY, AS WELL AS TO REACH AGREEMENT ON A TREATY ON GENERAL AND COMPLETE DISARMAMENT UNDER STRICT AND EFFECTIVE INTERNATIONAL CONTROL."
