You may also inform Ronan that US does not RPT not favor being over specific about inspection and control in Irish resolution, believing that this issue can only be resolved satisfactorily in subsequent negotiations. To specify that control provisions apply only to non-nuclear states in our view prejudices outcome of negotiations. If Irish make any changes in operative para 3 we would hope it would go in direction of more generalized reference to control rather than being more specific.

You should coordinate approach to Irish with UKDel.
