INFORMATION MEMORANDUM

The Air Force has contracted for the development of an operational plan for a Minuteman Launch on warning demonstra-The demonstration would be a Minuteman operational training launch from Vandenberg in response to a detection of a Soviet missile launch. Test objectives would be demonstration of a Minuteman launch reaction time less than the nominal 25 minute flight time of a Soviet ICBM attacking

OSD 3.3(b)(1) This demonstration would add credibility to the statements in the SECDEF Posture Statement last year and this year stating that we have a launch on warning capability. Such a demonstrated capability could mitigate arguments on the low survivability of Minuteman in the face of increasing Soviet ICBM throw weight and accuracy. On the negative side, it could revive emotional responses in Congress to discussion of "Launch on Warning!"

Tom Reed is apparently guiding the demonstration planning. You may wish to discuss timing and/or SALT implications with him.
