MEMORANDUM FOR MR. BUNDY

SUBJECT: British Guiana Election

1. CIA has worked out a projection based on the returns thus far.
2. Cheddi is doing much better than expected, and the odds are probably no better than about 6 to 5 that the opposition parties will win by one seat.
3. This promises to be a real cliff-hanger. We will probably have some more returns by the end of the day ~~xxx~~ but we may not know the outcome for sure until sometime tomorrow.
