ON 7 SEPTEMBER 1963 NGO DINH NHU SAID THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF VIETNAM (GVN) HAD SUFFICIENT RESERVES TO CONTINUE HE ALSO ORDERED VIETNAMESE SOLDIERS OPERATING FOR TWENTY YEARS. TO OPEN FIRE ON AMERICANS OR FOREIGNERS INVOLVED IN ACTS HOSTILE TO THE GVN.

ON THE EVENING OF 7 SEPTEMBER NGO DINH

NHU CALLED A MEETING OF ALL SENIOR TROOP COMMANDERS IN THE SAIGON/ CHOLONG AREA INCLUDING AIRBORNE AND MARINE BRIGADE COMMANDERS.
