Clasms that the coup had been a very smooth operation; had already talked to Panama by radio (according to later conversation, col. said the only radios operating at that time the Chilean naval radios, or one radio that Eply, US Wavg man, had.)

Getting out: It's imposible for a few days.

Dangerous now: no, everything completely under contron; shooth operation.

How was it done? casual answer; started mobilizing by 4:30am, claims that
hr. later, chile under mil. controll

Flanned ahead: laugh, "it never goes this smoothly unless planned in advance"
Third time down; came alone; had been working on ships: advisor invited by
Chilean navy. "Whenever I go to a country, I'm invited by the military."

Liked living in Panama cauz could keep track of happenings in LA Would the US recognize new gov't? That's up to the politicians now, but I don't think there's much doubt ab ut it.

Checking in at counsel? Others yes, but it's the last place that he would go. why? effect that: they don't have much truet for what the military is doing (Ie counsel doesn't like to get involved in military activities. People in Vina report directly to embassy).

Same night, conversation with Raul, Urugay.

Raul San Martin Martinez (b. 1943)

(Father writes sports fr Bordaberry's most imp't paper)

Travel on Greek line, owned by An-Greek as satlor (Had been living in suite in liramar since Sept 4) Shared it with Ricardo and wife, a red-haired woman (mother of red-head?) Ricardo worked for "Nixon-Repub. type newspaper in BA) Also in suite: Leo (Urug), a sailor, rust cleaner

Col. Ryan had stopped at hotel desk and asked for either Raul or Ricardo.

Sept 13 AM: Ryan ignores Creter and goes up elevator.

Says: Allende is bar. in Vina (seems to think that no one knows this) "I always know what's happening 24-48 hrs in advance" (in reference to roads and airports being opened).

Car: White chev. Impala, station wagon. Dip. plates (M (CD912)

Wife's car: Ford SW, Calif. plates (hasen't yet put dip. plates on) (Car originally bought from Univ. Ford in San Diego)

Pigs (Very anti-Kennedy for failure to give air support at BofP; says he was ready to to from Key West. Very anti-communist; Would ha e never had these problems with Chile if it hadn't been for Cuba. Says all prof. military disliked the military strategy in VN. Been in close to 20 years.)

Sept 13:

Woman in British consulate cays that 4 US ships off Arica at time because of UNITAS.

British consul: Mr. Kendrick (didn't seem too informed of events - worried about race horse of his in Stgo.

Military security attaché stranded in Vina instead of being at his post in Stgo.

Sept 14 Am

Creter: Says, in feferense to tourist trip to Bolivia, that he thinks there will be problems in Bolivia. will be going there, yes, after Chile. Ryan (Brief case: carried 38 calib. short nosed Police Special amongst classified papers) (Describes truck drivers as "real heroes" of this thing, they brought the

gov't down) Chilean navy fired across the bow of the Playa Larga to get it to stoo, intersepted radio to Havana

Allende perpretrated the June 29th mini-coup; "dunse" Souper made a "mess out of

it" because the other Army people weren't behind him.

Night of 14, 6756 r says that Dayis might have a ride back to Stgo for them. (Davis says he goes weekly to Vina and Valpo.)

Davis was in Vina on 9/19 in full dress uniform. (only time in uniform)

Capt. Davis and DCM Tompkins (newly arrived ass't to N. Davis) were coming to

Davis was Ryan's Boss, Aidn't know why Tompkins and wife were co ming along. At US Naval Mission office met Roger Fraunfelder (here for 2 years) (was Chilean suboficial in office). Said that the crane engineer hadn't gotten in. He had been here before from Panama and didn't want to come back . Mane Larry Dirks came up - seems to be Ryans counterpart at Talcakhuano.

Rrauenfelder said they (?) want to talk to Creter (said this to Ryan). Says subs in harbor were WWII; Says UNITAS was cancelled, that, ha ha, that was one of the tricky things they (Chileans) did so that no one would know this

was happening.

UNITAS set for Tues, 9/11; Chileans ships set out for UNITAS 9/10 in PM, sailed back in. Where are US ships now? "Oh, right out there." What happened to them? "Oh, I suppose there just chigging right on by."

How many? 5 (2 destroy, 2 dest. escorts and 1 sub) No big ships. Any other US citizens stranded here? No, just Creter whom you've already met (how did he know this?)

RF: "Since I've been here I've become a real supporter of the cause." Ryan said number killed in STgo as of 9/14 was 1,500-3,000 (repeated this ofterm) How did that ha en? "Well, they're doing search and d estroy missions like in VN" (This was where JFK conversation with Ryan, at his house, comes in)

US community in Vina (info. from Ryan as ride to Chief Eply- radio operators-house: Includes: Doug Gorman (Prudential/Grace lines rep); Ryans, Fraunfelders; Ed. Johnson -military person there only 3 weeks-, 2-3 PC families, a USIS person, and Paul

Santa Elena (US, Prudential/Grace Line?) had unloaded and received permission to leave. Supposed to call at Valpo on 9/10 and leave by 24:00 the following day. Says it was distarging tallow for soap, according to Prudential man in Santiago. Doug Gorman told Ryan that it had "stuff" on board which had to maxkaxenxkaxes get out with (it had inloaded and loaded during the tith). As the ship was leaving the har or, the Chilean navy morse coaded it to stop 3 times, but no one on board knew code; finally they fired 2 rounds across its bows to stop it).

Arrive at Chief Paul Eply's house to radio to States. Could use the radio whenever they wanted to in periods of crisis (Normally only 45 minutes twice a day). Only radio in Vina had that much power to reach Panama beside Chilean

Ryan says they bombed the Moneda with rockets and "you'd have to be a real hamburger to miss with a mocket."

Ryan says that Davis will be driving back to Stgo on that day. Ryan describes the function of the military attache as, "to soy". Ryan, at this point, says that R. Davis is No 3 in Chile behind N Davis and Tompkins (who still was too new to do anything).

Ryan carried an ID from the Armada de Chile (yellow with blue border), on

front, It. Col. Patrick Ryan; on back, picture and description.

In bar, Ryan says he took, ersonally, some Chilean navy man to US on \$1 million. shopping spree for equipment.

Met Ed. Johnson affiliated with RxRxxxxx Ryan, Fraunfelders office.

None had known others before they got to chile.
Drive back to Stgo. with Davis.
Ryan claims that R Davis is 3rd on "IR's list.
