### TECHNICAL SCHEDULE.

This technical schedule sets forth the defense areas selected pursuant to Article II (3) of the Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Kingdom of Denmark, pursuant to the North Atlantic Treaty, concerning the defense of Greenland, signed in Copenhagen on April 27, 1951.

#### NARSSARSSUAQ.

The Narssarssuaq area, and sites in the vicinity, described as follows:

#### Narssarssuag

The area bounded by: 61° o2' and 61° 16' North

45° 15' and 45° 32' West

#### <u>Simiutaq</u>

Skovfjord and the waters surrounding it up to one mile from the shore line.

An area of about 45 acres 1 1/2 miles SSE from Frederiksdal at the entrance to Amitsuarssuk Fjord, approximately at 59°58'12" N and 44°39' W.

#### SØNDRE STRØNFJORD.

The Søndre Strømfjord area, and sites in the vicinity, described as follows:

## Søndre Stromfjord

The area bounded by:  $.66^{\circ}47^{\circ}$  and  $.67^{\circ}$  10 N  $.50^{\circ}15^{\circ}$  and  $.51^{\circ}$  15 W



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Cruncher Island - The unnamed island south of the Simiutaq

Island located in the mouth of Søndre Strømfjord at approximately 66°01' 30" N and 53°

33' W and the waters surrounding it up to one mile from the shore line.

#### THULE .

The Thule area, and sites in the vicinity, described as follows:

## Northern boundary:

Beginning at the shore south of Thule on 76° 33' N, following the divide to point 300 m (76° 33' N, 68° 45' W); thence due east to longitude 68° 30' W; thence northward to the shore of Wolstenholme Fjord; thence following the shore line eastwards to the edge of the ice cap.

## Southern boundary:

76° 25° N from the shore to the edge of the ice cap.

Eastern boundary:

The edge of the ice cap.

To the West the area includes the territorial waters west of the land area.

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
