- K: Bill, Sy Herst just called Larry with a statement he has all the committee material on Allende with regard to the 40 and that most of the stuff he claims he got from CIA.
- C: Ch, sure.
- K: Where else did he get it?
- C: Well, I don't know.
- K: He says we had \$1.5 million set aside to overthrow Allende.
- C: He could have gotten this from two or three different places.
- K: Like where?
- C: We had to give a detailed breakdown to McClellen. Nedsy we had to give a report to.
- K: To who?
- C: Nedsy, the Chairman of our House Committee.
- K: He claims he has notes from me and the 40 committee.
- C: From you?
- K: Yes.
- C: I don't know if we have that memo around like that.
- K: And that the Agency people are claiming I am the biggest threat to democracy. Do you have any idea how much money was spent?
- C: I have a detailed breakdown of it.
- K: How much is it?
- C: You are in the \$6 million category. But \$500-600,000 was spent...

C: I will try to get hold of Hersh and see what he has.
