

I. INTRODUCTION

- A. This plan will provide guidance for operations and procedures designed to ensure effective security of sensitive and classified interests, high value or unique NEST equipment, and protection of personnel during NEST retrograde operations.
- B. All personnel involved with NEST support are responsible to the provisions of this plan and for mutual assistance in their implementation and enforcement.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES

- A. While in transit and during intermediate stops, the ranking accompanying DOE official is responsible for the protection of all classified matter.
- B. While in transit and during intermediate stops, authority for the protection of all classified matter may be delegated by the ranking accompanying DOE official to the ranking accompanying NV Safeguards and Security Division (SSD) official.

III. PLAN

A. Classification Levels and Categories


The NEST was authorized to deploy with the following classified matter. Each category may have been Confidential, Secret, or Top Secret.

- B. Protection of Classified Matter
 - a. Classified Crypto Matter
 - The DOE NEST Security Officer (SO) will courier classified COMSEC matter from the field location to the home office. All COMSEC matter will be placed in the personal custody

b. Classified Non-Crypto Material

Classified matter in transit will be either locked in security repositories or in the personal custody of authorized individuals with handcarry authority. Proper marking and packaging requirements will be assured.

- C. Classified Documents
 - Classified documents to be returned to the home office must be marked, double wrapped, and addressed in accordance with established DOE/NV Orders 5635.1. It is the custodian's responsibility to assure this is accomplished.
 - 2. Classified waste will be torn several times and placed in classified waste bags. This will also be the custodian's responsibility. These bags will be turned over to WSI for disposition in the hammermill document destructor located in the U. S. border town.
