COMMENTS ON MIGHTY BERRINGER - COURUS ISSUES:

AS IS THE CASE IN MANY OF THE MAJOR FIELD EXERCISES, A NUMBER OF SIGNIFICANT ISSUES AROSE. SOME WERE EXPECTED, OTHERS WERE NOT. HERE IS A LISTING OF SOME OF THE ISSUES. DISCUSSIONS OF THESE ISSUES ARE CONTAINED IN THE MONITOR LOGS AND DATABASE COMPUTER PROGRAM.

- A) CONSTITUTION, DEPLOYMENT AND SUPPORT OF EST AND ADVANCED TECHNICAL PARTIES.
- B) EVACUATION OF MONTREV CITIZENS INTO THE UNITED STATES.
- C) SUCCESSION OF COMMAND AS ONE AREA OF EXPERTISE FINISHES AND ANOTHER STARTS. EXAMPLE, DOD FORCES REMOVE TERRORISTS, WHICH LEADS TO MORE STANDARD SECURITY, WHICH LEADS TO NEED FOR TECHNICAL CONCENTRATION, ETC.
- D) DISPOSITION OF IND IN U.S. CUSTODY IN A FOREIGN COUNTRY.
- E) ADVANTAGEOUS SITUATION FOR ONE GROUP THAT PRESENTS DISADVANTAGES FOR ANOTHER. EXAMPLE, QUICK ASSAULT BY DOD FORCES.
- F) DISABLEMENT TECHNIQUE DECISION AND NEED TO GAIN DATA NEEDED TO SAFE ANOTHER DEVICE.
- G) NEED FOR QUICK DECISION IN THE FIELD VS. OBTAINING PRIOR HEADQUARTERS APPROVAL.
- H) DISPOSITION (SAFING, SHIPPING) OF NUCLEARLY SAFED DEVICE.
- I) NEED FOR MORE OR LESS DETAILED PLANNING FOR A REALISTIC AND EFFECTIVE EXERCISE.
