In order to identify those employees and their dependents who should receive a special physical examination under "Hoscow Viral Study", the Post Security Officer is requested to furnishtthe Medical Division with a quarterly report listing those employees who are due for home leave six months hence. The report will only include those individuals who, by virtue of where they worked or lived, were subject to the most exposure.

The first report is due in the Department as soon after January 1, 1966 as possible and would include all persons identified for the special examination who are eligible for home leave during the period January 1 thru September 30, 1966. Subsequent reports are due in the Department April 1, July 1, October 1 and would cover the quarter starting six months from the date of the report, i.e. the report dated April 1 would cover October, November and December.
