4. EVALUATION OF ABOVE SUBMARINE CONTACTS.

A. IN OR NEAR QUARANTINE AREA REMAINS ESSENTIALLY THE SAME AS LAST REPORT - 6 KNOWN CONTACTS, (5 FOXTROTS AND C-21 AS YET UNIDENTIFIED) AND AT LEAST 3 MORE POSSIBLES.

B. NEW ACTIVITY HAS CENTERED OFF ARGENTIA. FOUR POSSIBLES REPORTED.

C. NO ADDITIONAL ACTIVITY REPORTED VICINITY AZORES SINCE DEPARTURE TEREK.

D. THE SUBMARINES AROUND QUARANTINE AREA ARE ESTIMATED TO HAVE BEEN OUT OF HOME 30 TO 40 DAYS AND WILL HAVE TO REFUEL/REPLENISH FROM TEREK. PROCEED TO CUBA, OR COMMENCE EASTERLY RETURN TRANSIT IN THE NEAR FUTURE. PRESENT INDICATIONS POINT TO EASTERLY MOVEMENT OF 3 UNITS.
