JOINT EMBASSY/USIS MESSAGE

VISIT OF POLARIS SUBMARINE SAM HOUSTON TO IZMIR WAS SUCCESS FROM ALL POINT OF VIEW. TURKISH PRESS GAVE VISIT MAXIMUM FAVORABLE COVERAGE. PLACEMENT IN METROPOLITAN PRESS (ISTANBUL, IZMIR, ANKARA) APRIL 13/15 TOTALED 1600 COL/INS, EQUIVALENT TWO COMPLETE TURKISH NEWSPAPERS. RESMIL POSTA (ANKARA) HEADLINE APRIL 15 IS INDICATIVE OF TURKISH ATTITUDE. "SUBMARINE WHICH SCARES SOVIETS IS IN IZMIR." TURKISH RADIO FEATURED SPECIAL FIVE-MINUTE SPOT APRIL 14 IN PRIME EVENING TIME, INCLUDING STATEMENT BY COMMANDING OFFICER SAM HOUSTON. MOST PAPERS FRONT-PAGED STORY AND PICTURES; COMHURIYET FEATURED BY-LINED ARTICLE BY TURKISH ADMIRAL ON ADVANTAGES POLARIS; USIS BACKGRÖUNDERS AND ADVANCE PHOTOS WIDELY USED.
