DEA S/A'S LEARNED THAT THE ATTACK STARTED AT APPROXIMATELY 1715 HOURS AND LASTED UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 2230 HOURS. POLICE SURVIVORS ESTIMATED THE SIZE OF THE ATTACKING FORCE AS 600-800 ATTACKERS. SOURCE BELIEVES ARE COLOMBIAN. THE POLICE SOURCE BELIEVES THIS BECAUSE OF THE TWO MEN'S ACCENTS AND WORD USAGE AND BECAUSE THEY WERE COMPARING THIS ATTACK WITH ATTACKS WHICH HAD PREVIOUSLY OCCURRED IN COLOMBIA. POLICE SOURCES REPORT THAT SEVERAL OF THE ATTACKERS WERE VERY YOUNG, WITH SOME AS YOUNG AS THIRTEEN YEARS OF AGE. POLICE SOURCES ALSO REPORT A NUMBER OF FEMALES AMONG THE ATTACKERS.

18. DEA S/A'S PERSONALLY OBSERVED SEVERAL OF THE SURVIVING POLICE AS WELL AS FALLEN POLICE TO HAVE ONE OR MORE FULL MAGAZINES OF AMMUNITION, AND AT LEAST ONE

INSTANCE A COMPLETELY LOADED HANDGUN. INJURED CIVILIANS WHO WERE EVACUATED VIA US AIRCRAFT INDICATE THAT SOME POLICE REMOVED THEIR UNIFORMS AND TRIED TO ESCAPE. THE TOWNSPEOPLE REPORTEDLY POINTED OUT A DOES MAJOR AND CAPTAIN FOR THE SENDERO LUMINOSO ATTACKERS. THESE TWO INDIVIDUALS, ALONG WITH A FEMALE, WERE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN SUMMARILY EXECUTED IN THE SQUARE.

- 19. A FEMALE ATTACKER WAS CAPTURED ALIVE AND TRANSPORTED TO LIMA. SHE WORE BLACK SLACKS AND TOP WITH A RED ARMBAND. THIS FEMALE ALSO WORE A SILVER EARRING WITH A BLUE STRIPE IN HER LEFT EAR. POLICE SOURCES CLAIM THIS EARRING SIGNIFIES THAT THE FEMALE COMMANDED A SQUAD OF FIVE PERSONS. POLICE SOURCES ALSO REPORT THAT A RED EARRING WITH A GOLD STRIPE SIGNIFIES COMMAND OF FIVE SQUADS OR TWENTY-FIVE PEOPLE, AND THAT A GOLD STAR ON A RED BACKGROUND SIGNIFIES CONTROL OF APPROXIMATELY FIFTY PERSONS.
- 20. IN A SEPARATE INTERVIEW, A CITIZEN SOURCE REPORTS HAVING BEEN A PASSENGER ON A SMALL BUS ON THE OUTSKIRTS GONFIDENTIAL

OF UCHIZA ON THE AFTERNOON OF 3/27/89. THE SOURCE REPORTS THAT THE BUS WAS STOPPED AT APPROXIMATELY 1500 HOURS BY A NUMBER OF ARMED INDIVIDUALS, SOME OF WHOM WORE RED ARM AND HEADBANDS. THE AVERAGE AGE OF THE PERSONS STOPPING THE BUS WAS 15-20 YEARS OF AGE AND THEY WERE ARMED WITH FAL, AKM, AND MPG WEAPONS. THE SOURCE SPECULATED THAT SOME OF THE ARMED ASSAILANTS MAY HAVE BEEN COLOMBIAN, BASED ON ACCENT, WORD USAGE, AND LIGHT COMPLEXIONS. THE ASSAILANTS ARE REPORTED TO HAVE ARRIVED AT THE SCENE IN SEVERAL NEW PICKUP TRUCKS AND MOTORCYCLES.

- 21. THE SOURCE STATED THAT ALL OCCUPANTS OF THE BUS WERE DETAINED UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 2000 HOURS, BUT THAT NO ONE WAS INJURED OR HURT BY THE ASSAILANTS AND THAT THE ASSAILANTS DID NOT ASK FOR OR TAKE ANY MONEY FROM THE OCCUPANTS. THE SOURCE REPORTS THAT ALL OCCUPANTS OF THE BUS WERE FORCED TO PRODUCE IDENTIFICATION AND THAT THE ASSAILANTS KEPT A RECORD OF THIS INFORMATION.
- 22. THE SOURCE REPORTS THAT THE OCCUPANTS WERE LECTURED FOR HOURS REGARDING THE "POPULAR WAR". DURING THESE LECTURES THE ASSAILANTS REPORTEDLY STATED THAT

THE "YANQUIS" ARE FIGHTING THE NARCOTICS TRAFFICKERS,
BUT THE TRAFFICKERS ARE SUPPORTING THE POPULAR WAR
(AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT OF PERU), AND THAT THE
NARCOTICS TRAFFICKERS OFTEN SUPPLY AMMUNITION AND MONEY
TO THE WAR EFFORT. THE SOURCE REPORTS THAT THE
LECTURES ALSO INCLUDED A GREAT DEAL OF ANTIGARCIA/ANTI-APRA RHETORIC.

23. POLICE ARE ESTIMATING THAT THEY MAY HAVE INFLICTED AS MANY AS FIFTY CASUALTIES ON THE ATTACKERS AT UCHIZA. NO BODIES OF KNOWN ASSAILANTS, HOWEVER, WERE RECOVERED AND SPECULATION IS THAT THE DEAD AND INJURED WERE REMOVED PRIOR TO THE ARRIVAL OF THE PERUVIAN ARMY ON GONFIDENTIAL

24. A LETTER FROM

DATED 3/17/89 AND ADDRESSED TO AMBASSADOR WATSON, WAS DELIVERED TO THE AMERICAN EMBASSY LIMA VIA PERUVIAN MAIL ON 3/29/89.

REPORTEDLY SAW, OVERHEARD AND CORROBORATED A SERIES OF EVENTS RELATED TO A BRIBE IN WHICH MAJOR FARFAN AND CAPTAIN MOSCOSO (WHO WERE ASKED FOR BY NAME AND THEN SUMMARILY EXECUTED BY SENDERO LUMINOSO DURING THE UCHIZA ATTACK ON 3/27/89) ALLOWED A TRAFFICKER AIRCRAFT TO LAND, LOAD WITH COCA DERIVATIVES, AND TAKE OFF WHILE CAPTAIN MOSCOSO WAS ON DUTY AT THE AIRPORT.

25. WHILE IT APPEARS THAT THE MOTIVE FOR THE UCHIZA ATTACK RELATES, AT LEAST IN PART, TO POLICE CORRUPTION AND DOUBLE DEALING, PERHAPS THE MOST SIGNIFICANT ASPECT IS THE INSIGHTS IT PROVIDES REGARDING TRAFFICKER/INSURGENT RELATIONS IN THE UPPER HUALLAGA VALLEY (UHV). POST WILL CONTINUE TO MONITOR THIS AREA VERY CLOSELY. LION
