Dear Dr. Boorstin:

I write with respect to the collection of Secretary of State Kissinger's papers that is to be stored at the Library of Congress. We understand that the Department of State has agreed that copies of government papers which Dr. Kissinger worked on or reviewed as Secretary of State may be included in the collection, subject to the terms of a Transfer Agreement signed on December 14, 1976 by you and by the Director of the Foreign Affairs Document and Reference Center of the Department of State. A copy of this Transfer Agreement is attached.

We have no objection to having the collection also include copies of government papers that Dr. Kissinger worked on or reviewed as Assistant for National Security Affairs, provided it is understood that such papers will be held by the Library on the same terms and conditions as those in the attached Transfer Agreement. If you agree that the terms and conditions of the Transfer Agreement shall be equally applicable to the papers in question, please indicate your acceptance by signing both the original of this letter and the enclosed duplicate. Kindly return the duplicate to us.

It should be noted that we have reviewed the papers in question and have taken steps to assure that they contain only copies and not any original records.

The undersigned, the authorized representatives of the Department of State ("the Department") and of the Library of Congress ("the Library"), hereby agree to the transfer of copies of certain papers, from the Department of State to the Library, under the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Described Papers. The described papers consist of copies of government papers which have been preserved solely for convenience of reference and which Henry A. Kissinger worked on or reviewed as Secretary of State or as Assistant to the President for National Security Affairs. They are more particularly described in the schedule attached hereto. The Department has taken steps to assure that the described papers include no original or record copies.
- 2. <u>Use</u>. The described papers shall be used only as a part of the Collection described in the Deed of Gift and Agreement between Henry A. Kissinger and the Library of Congress dated November 12, 1976 ("Deed of Gift").
- 3. Requests. The Library shall direct all requests, claims and legal actions with respect to any of the described papers to the Department or other agency or office that originated the paper. These requirements shall not apply to access under paragraphs 6 and 7(a) of the Deed of Gift. Existing government privileges with respect to the described papers are reserved.
- 4. Security Requirements. The Library shall adhere to the requirements referred to in the Letter from the Director of the Department's Office of Security to the Librarian of Congress dated November 16, 1976.
