There follows text of message sent CINCPAC, Honolulu Branch Hydrographic Office today. It is being promulgated immediately as a numbered HYDROPAC. 711.022

QUOTE North Pacific Ocean. Marshall Islands.

Eniwetok Atoll. Danger Area (reference NM 21, Paragraph 2716, May 23, 1953). Effective immediately and until approximate end of June, 1954. Modify limits of danger area as follows: Sector of circle of 450 miles radius centered in latitude 12 degrees 00 minutes north, longitude 164 degrees 00 minutes east, included between bearing 240 degrees from center, thence clockwise to bearing 095 degrees from center. Modified limits of danger area comprise above described sector, plus those remaining portions of danger area described in referenced NM. Grave hazards, as consequence of tests of military weapons, will exist in area. All possible precautions will be taken to insure against incidence of injuries to human life or property within danger area. If necessary, warnings
