SUBJECT: Exercise IVORY ITEM

You indicated you were generally pleased with the way the recent exercise went, and we were too. / We learned/a lot and found some things that need follow-up.

Some points in the exercise may need clarification. The way we conducted the exercise -- that is, a somewhat leisurely discussion -may tend to give the impression that there is time for dialogue. The scenario, of course, was designed that/way. As you are aware, time available to assimilate the required information and make a decision in a real situation may be quite short, particularly if SLBMs are introduced. In that regard, I think it is important to call to your attention that references to ICBM launch rates during the exercise used different time baselines.
