MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR, JOINT STAFF

SUBJECT: Follow-on Actions to NMCC Session, 28 January

- 1. (S) Admiral Hanson passed to me the following information and actions from the SecDef following Saturday's meeting in the NMCC. I have discussed them with General Brown and he asked that I forward them to you for action or information as appropriate.
- a. Laser Operations Against Communications or Other Satellites. SecDef wants an update on what the US is doing with respect to use of lasers to damage/destroy/inactivate enemy satellites. He also wants to know what the Soviets are doing. Finally, he would like a review of what the US is doing to protect our satellites against such operations. Action: Admiral Hanson and I agreed DR&E should handle this one, but Joint Staff should assure General Brown receives copy of any reply to SecDef.
- b. Launching of Defense Satellites on Short Notice. SecDef would like a report on research or programs underway for the US to have the ability to launch a communications or warning satellite on very short notice. Action: DR&E under conditions stipulated in subparagraph l.a. above.



- d. Radars to Detect SLBM Attack. SecDef would like a report on the program status of improved radar to detect SLBM attacks, to include when the radars will become operational and their capabilities. Action: Joint Staff in conjunction with the Air Force.
- e. NEACP Communications. SecDef would like a report on what is being done to improve secure communications with the NEACP, Action: Joint Staff.
- f. Communications Checks. SecDef would like to conduct communications checks in the clear with the Presidential party away from Washington. Some checks should be made with the President himself. Action: Joint Staff.

g. <u>False Alarms</u>. SecDef would like a report on false alarms experienced within the NMCS from the inception of our early warning capabilities (General Brown directed this Saturday). <u>Action</u>: Joint Staff.
